Item 1: To consider and approve the proposed Syllabus, credits, and scheme of Examination for the following Programs to be introduced by the Centre for Languages and Communication.

- 1. Ph. D in English
- 2. Certificate in German
- 3. Certificate in French

The Scheme of Examinations and Syllabus of the Programs were placed before the Departmental Committee for consideration. The Departmental Committee after deliberations approved the agenda as enclosed with these proceedings. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

pllowing issues were discussed and suggestions put forth by the Departmental Committee members:

Dr. Sarju Devi, Head of the Department, introduced all the external and internal experts on the panel.

Prof. R. P. Singh- External Expert

Inputs for the Program: Ph. D. in English

- 1. The syllabus should be multidisciplinary and should be research-oriented.
- 2. Folk literature should be incorporated.

Prof. A. S. Adhikari- External Expert

Inputs for the Program: Ph. D. in English

- 1. Different style sheets such as APA, Chicago, Howard, etc. should be incorporated.
- 2. The focus should be on emerging and contemporary areas in theories and criticism.

Dr. Palu Manoj- External Expert

Inputs for the program: Certificate in German (CIG)

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1. Approved syllabus and scheme of examination Certificate in German.

2. The program is designed well and it was suggested that paper description should be revised; Precis writing should be replaced with unseen passages and Essay writing should be replaced with paragraph writing.

3. Some intermediate-level grammar topics should be removed from the certificate level program and should be included later in higher levels, such as Trennbareverben and ModalVerben (only a

few of them should be incorporated), Partizip II should be removed.

4. Course content should be taught in a very simple manner by incorporating examples from situational conversations, as advised by the external expert.

Prof. Ajith Kanna- External Expert

Inputs for the program: Certificate in French (CIF)

 Course content should be taught in a very simple manner by incorporating examples from situational conversations and linguistics jargon should be avoided, as advised by the external expert.

2. Paper descriptions should be revised.

3. Core skills should be taught in the given sequence; Listening, Speaking, Reading, Writing by focusing more on a practical approach.

4. Approved syllabus and scheme of examination Certificate in French.

Note: The Departmental Committee Members found that most of the elements were part of the syllabus and rests of the suggestions have been incorporated in the syllabus and curriculum for the final discussion in Academic Council Meeting.
