FACULTY OF AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES



BACHELOR OF EDUCATION:

Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) is an undergraduate course undertaken for the purpose of establishing a career in teaching. The right to free and compulsory education for children (RTE Act 2009) came into force from April 2010. The act emphasizes on quality education for every child with the view to bring about quality education in schools. At present, the need for trained teachers is very high as there is lot of stress on quality teaching and compulsory schooling. To become a successful professional in teaching field, one should have a minimum qualification of teaching and that is Bachelor of Education. Bachelor of Education programme in the SGT University comprises of three broad interrelated curricular areas.



1. Perspectives in Education -This includes course related to child development, contemporary India, learning and teaching, knowledge and curriculum etc. These courses help the students to develop deep understanding about the basics of teaching profession.

2. Curriculum and Pedagogic studies -This helps in the development of teaching skills which enables to become an efficient teacher.

3. Practical learning- This is a part of course curriculum and is a visible strength of the programme. Such project enables students in putting their theoretical knowledge of the discipline into practice leading to holistic development of future teachers.

Teachers are appointed in schools run by Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti and Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan. They can also find placement as counselor (with M.A in Psychology and Diplomas related to guidance and counselling), education consultants, curriculum developers, subject and pedagogy experts in public and private sector companies. One can start his/her own school after having B.Ed. Degree and can work in NGO.

Moreover, Students may move to next level that is M.Ed or M.A in Education to teach at college and university level.

MASTER OF EDUCATION:

After B.Ed., students can pursue Master of Education (M.Ed.) in any Indian university or teacher-training institutes offering the course. M.Ed is designed to acquaint students about the methodology of educational research and experimentation of new techniques of teaching. This course particularly introduces you to new levels of teaching processes. Students who have successfully qualified their bachelors of education (B.Ed) from a recognized institution are eligible to apply.

Course provides opportunities to students who want to be teachers or educators to extend and deepen their knowledge and understanding related to developments and issues in education course. It is designed to build and strengthen knowledge of methodology of educational research and getting yourself acquainted with social and psychological aspects of teaching and education. Due to unparallel development in the field of education during the last few decades, the need was felt for such programs and courses, which can fill the void of expertise in this domain.


FACULTY OF NURSING

FACULTY OF ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES

Allied Health Science has become a sought after field of education. It has gained huge importance over the years looking at the huge demand of such professionals. A paramedic is a professional who helps the doctors in specialized areas and facilitates for better diagnosis, treatment and therapy. The increase in number of patients, variety of diseases and the demand for immense treatment have paved the way for paramedical professionals who are expert technicians or therapists providing better quality to human healthcare. Paramedics are the key players in the Health & Medical Sector. Without paramedics, the entire health industry may become almost non-functional. Many committees and experts have highlighted the importance of paramedics in healthcare delivery in the past, including the National Knowledge Commission, which placed more importance on producing more paramedical professionals than doctors. In fact, diagnosis has become so dependent on technology that the role of allied health staff has become vital in delivering successful treatment. There is tremendous scope for employment in government and private sector both in teaching and other fields in all the courses under the faculty.



DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAL LAB TECHNOLOGY

Medical Laboratory Technology is concerned with the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of diseases through the use of clinical laboratory tests. A lab technician works behind the scenes as a highly skilled specialist who performs tests that detect the absence or presence of disease. Results of the tests performed by these technicians are passed on to physicians so that they can treat patients and manage disease according to the findings. This program also equips candidates with the knowledge and skills required to handle advanced lab equipment.

The SGT University had realized its potential and established 'Department of Medical Laboratory Technology' in 2013 within the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences. At SGT we have a well-qualified, committed and motivated faculty. All the departments have well-equipped laboratories and we have our own hospital where through departmental postings students are trained in state-of-the-art laboratories of clinical biochemistry, clinical pathology and clinical microbiology and so they can get proper exposure required for enhancing their practical skills.



DEPARTMENT OF OPERATION THEATER TECHNOLOGY

An operating theater is a facility within a hospital where surgical operations are carried out in a sterile environment. An Operation Theater (OT) technologist forms an intrinsic part of any hospital. He is a member of a multidisciplinary team in operation theatres who plays an active role in smooth functioning of operation theatre. He assists anesthesiologist and surgical team during preoperative period and provides support to patients in PACU. He plays an important role in advance preparation of equipments that are necessary for various anesthesia / surgical procedures. He also looks after all the works related to management of the OT which includes managing the patients in & out of Operation Theater, care and maintenance of all the OT equipments as well as management of the staff.

The Department of Operation Theaters Technology was established under the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences, SGT University in year 2013. The department has fully equipped Operation Theaters for graduate and postgraduate students.



DEPARTMENT OF RADIO IMAGING TECHNOLOGY

The Department of Radio-Imaging technology under Faculty of Allied Health Sciences at SGT University, Gurugram, Delhi NCR, offers diagnostic services through a wide array of imaging modalities. The radiology department is equipped with a number of fixed radiography equipment like MRI, CT, DEXA, DSA, USG (3D, 4D), CR, IITV Fluoroscopy, Conventional Fluoroscopy, Stationary X-Ray Units, Portable X-Ray Units and Mammography Unit. The department of Radio Imaging Technology was established in 2013.

The department performs academic activities by presentations on scientific conferences and conducts research based studies (which involves the project works).



DEPARTMENT OF OPTOMETRY

Optometry is a paramedical field which deals with eyes, its structures, vision, visual system and vision information processing in human beings. Optometrists are trained to check any defect in vision, its treatment like prescribing and dispensing spectacles and contact lenses to improve vision.

The program is envisaged to develop a multipurpose ophthalmic manpower at paramedical level. The training will enable a student to become a competent person in providing services as an Optician, Optometrist, Refractionist and Ophthalmic assistant to the community in urban, semi-urban and rural settings in private, semi-Governmental and Governmental sectors.

Optometry is a 4 year undergraduate program with one year internship, which was established under the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences in 2013 at SGT University.



DEPARTMENT OF NUTRITION AND DIETETICS

Nutrition is a basic human need and a prerequisite to a healthy life. A proper diet is essential from the very early stages of life for proper growth, development and to remain active. Dietetics is the science which signifies how food and nutrition affects human health. The field of dietetics has a strong emphasis on public health and a commitment to educating all about the importance of making proper dietary choices.

Nutrition and dietetics studies bridge the connection between food, medicine and chemistry, focusing on the good and bad effects of alimentation on the human body.

The Department of Nutrition & Dietetics was established under the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences, SGT University in year 2014.

DEPARTMENT OF NEUROPHYSIOLOGY TECHNOLOGY

Neurophysiology Technology deals with physiology and neuroscience that is concerned with the study of the functioning of the nervous system along with tools of basic neurophysiologic research including electrophysiological recordings, such as Electroencephalogram (EEG), Nerve conduction studies (NCS), Electromyography (EMG).

The three year graduate programme in neurophysiology technology was introduced in the year 2014-2015 keeping in mind the increasing demand of neurophysiology technology as a discipline. At SGT, we have a well-equipped hospital with a specialized electrophysiology lab. The graduate programme students will benefit immensely with exposure to relevant patient tests in their practical classes.

DEPARTMENT OF MICROBIOLOGY

Microbiology is the study of microorganisms, which are unicellular or cell-cluster microscopic organisms. This includes eukaryotes such as fungi and protists and prokaryotes such as bacteria and certain algae. Viruses also come under this domain. Microbiology is subdivided into divisions like bacteriology, virology, mycology, parasitology to name a few. A scientist who specializes in the area of microbiology is called a microbiologist. The department came into existence in 2016 by introducing graduate programme in Microbiology. The department has well established labs with medical college hospital attached which caters to hundreds of patients thus exposes the students to various tests as well.

FACULTY OF MEDICINE & HEALTH SCIENCES



Dental College, Hospital & Research Institute) was started in the year 2002 and became a constituent faculty of the esteemed SGT University from the academic session 2013-14. The Faculty of Dental Sciences, with its excellent infrastructure, state of the art equipment and well experienced and highly qualified faculty has carved a niche for itself in the field of dentistry and is recognized amongst the top dental colleges across the country. As a source of dental education, the faculty aims at developing the student's, three dimensional personalities by dealing with:


- Continuous pursuit of knowledge, commitment to excellence & cultivation of moral & ethical values
- General dentistry at the outreach levels to the masses & needy people
- Basic & Advanced Research related to Oral diseases & Oral health care



Under Graduate Teaching Program (BDS) : Before the students enter the clinics to treat patients, they are given pre-clinical training including lectures, demonstration and complete practical training on dummies and phantoms mimicking the human oral cavity. After a strong base, the students are given a wide exposure on patients in clinics. The dental hospital has an OPD of more than 600 patients catering to both rural and urban population. Each case is personally supervised by a highly qualified and well experienced faculty member and every student in the clinic is personally guided. The students undertake basic & advanced level treatment procedures on patients in all nine departments.

Post Graduate teaching Program (MDS) : The post graduate program is designed to produce globally acceptable professionals who can choose to be competent clinicians, successful entrepreneurs, keen researchers or astute academicians. The post graduate sections are fully air conditioned and equipped with all state of the art equipment. The institute has various fully equipped minor and major operation theatres where surgeries are performed on a daily basis. The MDS course in lines with 'Dental Council of India', is largely application based which includes seminar presentations, journal club presentation, clinical case presentation, library dissertation, main dissertation, and training in all advanced treatment procedures. The post graduates training is at par with the global standards. Depending upon the specialty, the students are trained in all minor and major diagnostic and treatment methods. Eg: advanced diagnostic techniques, full mouth implants, sinus lift procedures, lasers, surgical procedures including cleft lip and palate surgery, esthetic rhinoplasty, reconstruction surgery, orthognathic surgery, pediatric treatment under conscious sedation, endodontic treatment with microscope etc.

Lasers and Implants are the need of the hour and therefore, the institute has special DIODE units and procedures like gingival depigmentation, frenectomy, crown lengthening, gingivectomy etc. can be carried out on day-to-day basis. Single to full mouth implants are done including sinus lift procedure, zygomatic implant etc.



Each Department lays high quality stress on research & innovation in the field of 'Dentistry and Applied Sciences'. Many faculty members are pursuing extramural research works in their choice of specialisations & all faculty, post-graduates & even under-graduates are encouraged to document scientific manuscripts in textbooks, journals etc. The departments also organize 'Continuing Dental Education (CDE)' programs, conferences, guest lectures, talks etc. on a regular basis to keep the students and faculty updated. The post graduate students and faculty members win awards and accolades at various national and international conferences and PG conventions every year. 

HOST A JOB SHADOW:

Employers can play a significant role in helping young people discover the world of work. Job Shadowing allows a student to spend a few hours (2-4) or a full day (6-8) with a professional working in the student's area of career interest. The student has the opportunity to experience first-hand what the job is really like and can establish the confidence to ask informed questions! This type of experiential learning can help students determine early on in their college career if their on the right path.

INFORMATIONAL INTERVIEWS:

Similarly, Informational Interviews are a great way to help students understand the world of work, careers, and employers. Informational interviews involve allowing a student to interview a professional about his/her work and own career journey. The time commitment is minimal, 30-45 minutes. Some of the information students want to learn about include: career roadmap to the corporate leader's current position, a typical day for the corporate leader, the joys and challenges of his/her job, any recommendations that the corporate leader may have for someone working to pursue employment in the field, and the culture of his/her organization.

EXTERNSHIPS:

Through Externships, which are training programs related to an area of academics or career interests that aim to give participants practical experiences in their area of interest. Externships are similar to internships, however, they tend to be shorter in duration, usually only a few days or a couple weeks, and involve a combination job shadowing, informational interviewing, and possibly a brief hands-on experience. The goal of an externship is to provide students with additional insights into a specific career.

We will encourage corporate leaders to get involved with students by volunteering to be a Mentors. Students want to learn firsthand from professionals in their career fields of interest. These experiential learning opportunities are highly valued as they allow students to learn about careers and industries in a deeper, more meaningful way. These connections could involve a range of activities, including an informational interview, job shadowing, site visits, resume reviews, mock interviews, or sharing your professional knowledge and experience. The commitment can be as little as one hour a semester, working with just one student or more than one student at a time.

Internally, we are establishing a Career Advisory Center which will assume a different hat altogether so that students come mere handshake away. This will be followed up by the establishment of a Center of Excellence for Industry Linkages.

SGTUEE 2019 (INFORMATION BROCHURE FOR UG/PG COURSES)

SGT University will conduct SGT University Entrance Exam (SGTUEE) for admission to various UG/PG Courses offered at its campus. SGTUEE comprises of Computer based test (CBT) to be held at designated centers, details of which will be made available upon slot booking (Hyperlink of Exam Portal) and Personal Interview (PI).

For UG Courses, students securing 75% and above in aggregate in Class XII (from any recognized board) will be exempted from SGTUEE.

The test is applicable for candidates seeking admission to undergraduate (UG), Post Graduate (PG) programs of all disciplines (except: MBBS, MD/MS, MDS, BDS, BAMS). Students who have cleared the mentioned national entrance exams with valid score JEE/JEE-Mains/CLAT/NIFT/GATE/CAT/MAT are exempted from SGTUEE. The minimum eligibility criteria will be as prescribed in respective course ordinance which is available on university website.

SGTUEE 2019: Process

Candidate who wishes to appear for SGTUEE 2019 must follow the following steps:

STEP 1: Registration

Students can apply for SGTUEE slot(s) online. Initially, candidate needs to login to the official website as a new user. To sign in as new user, the candidate must have a valid email ID. Once the login is successfully created the candidate can login and access the registration form.

STEP 2: Slot Booking

Once a candidate fills the registration form, it is expected of him/her to upload a valid (Adhar Card, Passport) photo ID along with Class X Mark sheet, the candidates will be given the choice to book their slot to appear in the SGTUEE. The candidates can select time and date as per their convenience. However, the slot will be granted only on the basis of availability.

Pattern

SGTUEE is a scholastic aptitude test of high school level conducted in online mode. The candidates will be able to check their results on the official website only. They will be required to log on to the official website with their respective user IDs to be able to access their results. The merit of the entrance exam for each course will be based on SGTUEE (75%) + Personal Interview (25%). As the University will be admitting through entrance exam for the first time, candidate will be allowed to take two attempts in the SGTUEE and whichever is the best in those two attempts will be considered. The University will not charge any extra fee for the second attempt.

SGTUEE 2019 will consist of **75 multiple choice questions** in the following sections:

FOR UG and MBA & MA (JMC) Courses:

SGTUEE 2019 will be conducted by SGT University. The SGTUEE is a computer-based test (CBT) in which a candidate gets a randomly generated test from a pool of questions. The number of questions and time limit of the test sections are pre-determined. The computer displays one question at a time and will display the next question only once a candidate has taken an action on it.

Aspirants can download SGTUEE sample question paper free of cost from the official website of the University.

SGT UNIVERSITY FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Q 1. How can I seek information on admission to undergraduate/ postgraduate/ M.Phil./ Ph.D. courses in SGT University?

Ans. You can seek information online for all undergraduate/ Post graduate/ M.Phil./ Ph.D. courses through the admission portal URL & follow the guidelines to proceed.

Q 2. I have registered online for the SGTUEE for UG/PG courses. Do I still need to fill up the offline form for the admission?

Ans. No, there's no offline form.

Q 3. Can I apply in multiple programmes/courses in an online form?

Ans. Yes, you may select all programmes/courses of your interest through a single online registration form.

Q 4. I made an error in my online registration form. Do I need to register again using different email-id?

Ans. Yes, you can register again.

Q 5. Is it possible to change/update the information provided by the applicant on the online application form,?

Ans. No, generally during admission, candidate can always modify any personal information submitted during registration process.

Q 6. Why am I not able to preview my application?

Ans. Please ensure you have completed the mandatory fields (marked with red asterisk) on every page.

Q 7. Do you have Hostel Facilities?

Ans. SGT University high quality accommodation, separate for boys and girls, on a shared basis, with clean and hygienic dining facilities is provided. University provides well furnished rooms with 24 hours power back-up, treated water, Wi-Fi. All hostels are provided with Security Guards round the clock. The Campus includes utility center, gym, and bakery shop.

Q 8. Is transport facility available from NCR Delhi to SGT University?

Ans. More the 40 university buses fly from Delhi NCR to the University. The detail chart of the bus routes is available on the official website.

Q 9. Are there any recreational facilities in the campus?

Ans. Yes, there are multiple societies functioning in the campus (Dance, Music, etc)

Q 10. Is there any medical facility in the campus?

Ans. Yes, SGT University has its own hospital which provides 24*7 services.

Q 11. I have got compartment in my XII exam, am I eligible for entrance exam?

Ans. Yes, you are eligible for entrance exam but the admission will be considered after clearing the compartment.

Q 12. If I have diploma, is entrance applicable for lateral entry?

Ans. Yes, you also have to appear for the entrance but the admission will be in the courses where lateral entry is permitted.

Q 13. Will there be a disadvantage for gap year candidates?

Ans. There is no disadvantage for gap year candidates and they would be treated at par with regular students. They should meet the requisite criteria for admission and must possess the necessary documents/ certificates at the time of admission.

Q 14. Will the applicants be given admission on first come, first serve policy for admission?

Ans. Admissions are not based on first come first serve policy. Instead, the applicants who have filled the online registration form and satisfy the criteria and cut-off for a particular programme/ course in a particular college will be considered for admission as per schedule for admission specified.

Q 15. Can I take admission in two different courses after the declaration of admission list?

Ans. You can secure seats in two different courses but need to decide a course within a specified time.

Q 16. I have completed my 12th from NIOS (National Institute of Open Schooling). Can I get admission?

Ans. Yes, you can get admission in a SGT University provided you have applied in an available programme/ course and meet the admission criteria.

Q 17. Is it important to have caste or tribe certificates in the name of a candidate/ applicant?

Ans. Yes, there should be a valid certificate on the name of the candidate/ applicant.

Q 18. If my result is awaited, Can I submit the online registration form?

Ans. Yes, you can submit the online registration form and even appear in SGTUEE.

HOW TO FILL THE APPLICATION FORM

1. The candidate must go through the Information Brochure carefully and familiarize himself/herself with the eligibility criteria for admission and other requirements before filling the Application Form.
2. Application Form should be filled in English only.
3. The candidate should fill in the Application Form in his/her own handwriting, neatly and legibly.
4. Overwriting/cutting/erasing in the Application Form should be avoided. It is advisable to first fill a photocopy of the form and then the main Application Form.
5. Correct and complete address should be filled in the Application Form failing which the responsibility for going astray of communication or any other implication shall lie with the candidate.
6. The candidate should write his/her father and mother's names against the relevant columns in the form, as given in the DMC and degree of the qualifying examination for admission.
7. The candidate should enter the date, month, and year of birth as recorded in the Secondary School Certificate or its equivalent certificate.
8. The candidate should affix a recent high contrast photograph, preferably on white background, in the space earmarked for it on the Application Form, wherever required. Photograph with a cap, hat, or dark spectacles is not permitted. Affix the photographs firmly with an adhesive and should not be pinned or stapled.
9. Request for change in particulars in the Application Form shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
10. Incomplete applications will not be entertained for processing.
11. The Application Form must be accompanied by all self-attested essential certificates.
12. The enclosures should be firmly tied or stapled to the Application Form.

MODE OF FEE PAYMENT

1. Fees may be paid by Demand Draft/through Payment Gateway/bank Transfer or any other mode approved by the University. The drafts are to be drawn in favour of "Shree Guru Gobind Singh Tricentenary University", payable at "New Delhi".
2. A candidate offered provisional admission by the Admission Cell/Counselors shall submit the Application Form duly completed in all respect to the Registration Branch and shall deposit the course fee with the Finance Branch (Collection Counter) so that registration formalities can be completed.
3. Student must obtain the receipt for every payment made to the University.
4. Fee shall not be accepted in part or in installments, unless specifically allowed by the competent authority of the University.
5. Delayed payments will attract late fee charges as prescribed by the University from time to time.
6. Student opting to withdraw his/her admission will be entitled for refund of the fee as per the norms prescribed by the UGC from time to time.
7. The last date for admission in Technical and Professional courses will be as notified by the regulatory councils i.e. AICTE, UGC, DCI, MCI, PCI, BCI, INC etc. and for rest of the courses as notified by University.
8. Refundable caution money submitted at the time of admission will be refunded within 6 months from the date of declaration of the result or from the date of withdrawal from the course, on production of NO DUES CERTIFICATE PRESCRIBED BY THE UNIVERSITY.

FEE STRUCTURE REVISION

The University reserves the right to decide the fee structure and review the same periodically as per the provisions of the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006, as amended from time to time, which mandates that the University shall be self-financed and shall not be entitled to receive any grant or financial assistance from the Government or any Board or Corporation owned or controlled by the Government. However, fee structure so approved by the University will be notified.

SCHOLARSHIPS/FEE CONCESSIONS

1. The University awards scholarships in the form of tuition fee concession to bonafide meritorious students as per University Scholarship Policy or Fee Concession as per the provisions of the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006, as amended from time to time.

Note: Immediately after entrance test, the candidates are required to report to their respective department for Viva-voce/Interview.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Candidates, who have appeared in the qualifying examination and whose results are awaited, may also apply. Such candidates will be considered for provisional admission subject to submission of relevant documents satisfying eligibility conditions at the time of counseling.
- Admission to the Ph. D. and M. Phil. shall be made strictly on the basis of merit of Entrance Examination to be conducted by the University. For all other courses, admission shall be made as per the eligibility criteria prescribed by the regulatory councils i.e. AICTE, UGC, DCI, MCI, PCI, BCI, INC etc. or as per the provisions of the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006, as amended from time to time.
- For entrance examination, the candidates will be given an OMR Answer Book containing questions with 04 choices against each printed therein. The seal of the Answer Book will be opened only after the announcement by the Invigilator and not before that.

- The candidates will be called for counseling in order of merit. All the original document (DMCs/Degrees/other Certificates) must be shown to the Counseling Committee for verification, failing which admission will not be allowed under any circumstances.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. No candidate shall be admitted to the course to which he/she is seeking admission unless he/she fulfills the eligibility conditions. Admission will be purely provisional subject to verification of the candidate's eligibility by the University as per laid down rules and regulations. In case, a candidate is found ineligible at a later stage, the provisional admission will be cancelled and the candidate will have no right for admission to the course or refund of fee paid by him/her.
2. No candidate shall be admitted to any university examination unless he/she has been enrolled/registered as a student of the university. This condition may be relaxed in respect of students or scholars studying under University's Student Exchange Programme with any other University/Deemed to be University/Autonomous Institution.
3. A candidate from other University shall be eligible for admission to this University only on the production of a Migration Certificate. However, the condition of production of Migration Certificate will not apply in case of students passing the equivalent examination from a foreign university recognized by UGC/MCI/DCI/any other Indian regulatory body.
4. In case of a real hardship, a student may be admitted provisionally at his/her own risk and responsibility subject to the condition that he/she shall submit his/her Migration Certificate to the University up to 31st December of the admission year.
5. If a candidate fails to submit the Migration Certificate even up to 31st December of admission year, he/she will not be allowed to appear in the annual examination. However, in a sheer hard case, the Vice-Chancellor may allow a candidate to appear in the examination provisionally on payment of a prescribed late fee and on submission of an affidavit from the First Class Magistrate to the effect that he/she is not appearing in any examination conducted by other University/Board simultaneously. If such a candidate fails to submit his/her Migration Certificate before the declaration of result, his/her result shall be withheld. However, in hard and deserving case, the Vice-Chancellor may allow the declaration of result on submission of Migration Certificate with a prescribed late fee within one year and with a prescribed late fee during the next two years of the declaration of main result.
6. The student, who is not registered with the University, shall pay to the University, at the time of admission, through the University Department/Faculty which he/she joins, University enrolment-cum-eligibility fee and the continuation fee. In case of re-admission of a student whose name has been struck off from the rolls of the Department/Faculty, he/she shall pay the prescribed fee for making necessary entries in the University register. However, no further fee for registration will be charged.
7. On registration, the student shall be issued the registration card by the Registration Branch through the respective HoD/Dean of Faculty in case of regular students, indicating the number under which his/her name has been entered in the register and that registration number shall be quoted in all correspondence with the University. In case of loss/misplacement, a duplicate copy of the registration card can be obtained by the student by making an application to this effect along with the prescribed fee.
8. Application for correction in the particulars of a student shall be entertained by the Registration Branch within 30 days from the date of registration without any fee. Applications received after this period shall be entertained only with the prescribed late fee.
9. Reservation policy shall be as per rules/Act.
10. The registered student is entitled to get a certified copy of the entries under his/her name on prescribed payment subject to the condition that such entries are not confidential or secret.
11. If a student remains absent from classes for a continuous period of seven working days without any valid reason, medical or otherwise, his/her name shall be struck off from the rolls of the University Department / constituent college concerned irrespective of the fact that he/she has paid his/her dues in part or full. However, the student may be re-admitted with the permission of the Dean of the Faculty concerned on the recommendation of Head of the Department on payment of such fee as prescribed for the purpose from time to time in addition to arrears of fee, if any; provided that the Head of the Department concerned is satisfied that if re-admitted, the student will not fall short of requisite percentage of attendance/lectures, etc.
12. Each candidate shall submit the following affidavits/Declaration-cum-Undertaking in the format given in the Information Brochure:
 - i) Anti-Ragging undertaking by the student.
 - ii) Anti-Ragging undertaking by the parent/guardian.
 - iii) Declaration-cum-Undertaking (Agreement Bond) by the parent/guardian.

IMPORTANT HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The students, admitted to the hostel, are assumed to be prudent persons, having sufficient maturity and understanding to live in an adult environment. Such living involves full respect for the rights of others, regard for self-discipline, high standard of honesty, and enviable moral conduct. These regulations have been framed not to restrict the conduct of individuals, but to ensure that a multitude of students should live and work harmoniously together with minimum of discord and maximum of misunderstanding.

1. Hostel residence is optional for all categories of students (Except Junior Residents (MD/MS), PG Studnets).
2. Hostel accommodation (if available) will be provided to the students for a period equal to duration of the concerned courses. However, if a student fails in the yearly end examination (two semesters) and not promoted to the next higher classes as per the provisions of the course ordinance, shall not be allowed to stay in the hostel under any circumstances.
3. Only upgradation of hostel is permitted, if available, subject to clearance of difference of charges.
4. Students seeking admission to the hostel shall apply separately on a prescribed form to the Chief Warden, SGT University through the Dean of the respective Faculty within 10 days of the admission to the 1st year/1st semester of the course. A copy of latest Medical Report should be attached to the Hostel Admission Form.
5. Each hostel resident shall carry two locks, one dustbin and a bucket with mug for his/her personal use. These items will not be provided by the University.
6. Hostel residents are not permitted to change their rooms without the permission of the Hostel Warden.
7. All hostel residents are expected to be in their rooms by the time fixed by Chief Warden/Hostel Warden. Those who are found out of room after the specified time will be marked absent. In case a room-mate is found absent after 10.00 P.M. without leave or prior intimation, the other room-mate shall report the matter immediately to the Hostel Warden/Chief Warden/some senior staff in the campus. If any student is found absent from the room during a surprise check at night, the room-mate will be considered to be in collusion with the absentee and will also held responsible for not reporting the matter.
8. Hostel residents shall show their Identity Card if so required by any officer of the University at any time.
9. It is mandatory for all the hostel residents to take permission for leaving the hostel. On working days, no permission to leave the hostel will be granted unless the student has obtained written permission from the Head of Department/Dean. If any hostel resident provides false information about his/her night stay out of hostel, it will be considered as an act of indiscipline, which shall warrant penal action.
10. Every hostel resident entering hostel after leave/leaving hostel for outstation is essentially required to enter his/her time of entry/exit in the hostel register along with an application to the Hostel Warden.
11. To maintain harmony and cogent atmosphere, no religious ceremony or party shall be allowed to be held in the hostel. However, hostel residents may celebrate birthday with prior permission of the Hostel Warden and such a celebration/party should be over by 9.00 P.M.
12. Hostel residents are permitted to watch TV located in the Common Room of the hostel till 10.30 P.M.
13. Ragging and/or harassment of any kind to other students is strictly prohibited. Necessary disciplinary action shall be taken against the delinquents as per 'Prevention of Ragging' Rules of the University.
14. Use of drugs/any form of alcoholic drinks/tobacco in any form/any other intoxicant or possession of any kind of ammunition/weapon of assault/fire-arm or use of abusive language is strictly prohibited in the hostel and University campus. Those who are found involved in such activities will be expelled from the hostel immediately and matter will also be reported to District administration/police.
15. Association of any hostel resident with any unlawful organization is strictly prohibited. If any hostel resident is found/reported involved in such activities by the University or District administration/police, the concerned hostel resident will be expelled from the hostel.
16. Lights & fans should be switched off and water taps shut off when these are not in use.
17. Use of electrical appliance of any kind except the room coolers during the summer months (April to September) is not permitted.
18. Consumption of 50 units per month/per student for non air conditioned rooms and 100 units per month/per student for air conditioned rooms is free, subject to modification by competent authority from time to time. The charges exceeding the permissible limit will be shared by all the occupants on pro rata basis and charged monthly.
19. Misuse of mobile phones in any manner including MMS, activities amounting to cyber crime and viewing of questionable websites in the campus is prohibited.
20. Washing of clothes in hostel is not permitted.
21. Hanging of clothes in the balcony on week days is not permitted. However, the hostel residents may use the balcony on Saturdays/Sundays and holidays to dry the clothes.
22. In case of damage to any building, furniture or other hostel/university property, the cost of repair and/or replacement along with appropriate penalty/fine will be levied on the delinquent(s) found to be immediately responsible. But, if the delinquent(s) causing the damage is unidentifiable, the cost and penalty shall be recovered from all the residents of the hostel/block/room on pro rata basis.

23. Hostel residents are required to divulge the information about the medical problem/allergy towards any medicine immediately, if any.
24. The hostel resident, suffering from a communicable disease or any other disease which requires constant medical attention, shall vacate the hostel unconditionally immediately on having knowledge of disease/ailment.
25. In case of any emergency/hospitalization, the University will contact the parents/local guardian of the hostel resident to take their advice. In case, due to any reason, the parent/guardian could not be contacted, then the decision taken by the University will be final and acceptable to the parents/guardian. All expenses incurred on resident's treatment will be borne by the parents/guardian.
26. If the hostel resident is not feeling well, he/she should seek medical help at the appropriate time. However, in case of emergency necessary help will be provided by the University on the request of the hostel resident to reach the hospital.
27. The students may be allowed to keep their vehicles in hostels. However, they will park their vehicles in the General Parking Area. Parking of vehicles in the Hostels will not be allowed.
28. Request for room allocation with specific location or partners cannot be assured. Nevertheless, efforts will be made to meet the desired request. If required by the University, the hostel resident may be asked to shift to another room.
29. Hostel residents are advised not to keep valuables with them in the room. Such items, if any, should be locked in their respective cupboards all the time. The University shall not be responsible for the loss of such personal belongings.
30. Each hostel resident shall be responsible for the furniture and the electrical fittings provided in his/her room. He/she should get his/her room checked for furniture/fittings & fixtures etc. at the time of allotment and hand over the charge of the same along with the room key while vacating the room to the Warden/Caretaker.
31. While vacating the room, the resident must ensure that bills of all services availed of by him/her are duly paid for speedy settlement of caution money. Submission of "No Dues Certificate" on the prescribed form is essential.
32. Hostel Warden will, appoint one or more student as "Prefect(s)" on the basis of academic merit out of top five students to coordinate between the Warden and the residents.
33. The University reserves the right to open any room whenever required.
34. Hostel residents are permitted to entertain their guest(s)/ guardian/parents in the Visitor's Room of the hostel only as per following visiting schedule :

Week days	: 07.00 A.M. to 08.00 A.M.
	: 04.00 P.M. to 07.00 P.M.
Sundays/Holidays	: 08.00 A.M. to 09.00 P.M.

However, in exceptional circumstances, parents may be allowed to visit their wards in the hostel room with prior permission of the Hostel Warden.
35. Except parents, female visitor(s)/ guest(s) is/are not allowed in the Boys' Hostels and vice-versa.
36. Parents/guardians/guests are not permitted to stay overnight in the hostel.
37. A non-hostel resident student may be allotted a room, if available, with the permission of the Hostel Warden and the Dean of the respective faculty subject to the following charges:

i) One quarter of the year or part thereof	: 25% of the annual charges
ii) Three to six months	: 50% of the annual charges
iii) More than six months	: Full charges
38. The hostel residents are required to take their meal(s) in the Mess only. The mess timings must be adhered to strictly. At present, the timings are as under:

i) Break Fast			
Working Days	:	07.45 A.M. to 08.45 A.M.	
Sundays and Holidays	:	08.00 A.M. to 09.00 A.M.	
ii) Lunch	:	01.00 P.M. to 02.00 P.M.	
iii) Dinner	:	07.45 P.M. to 08.45 P.M.	
39. No hostel resident is permitted to take meal(s) in the hostel premises/room(s). However, if a student is not in a position to go to the mess due to some genuine reasons, the Hostel Warden may grant permission to the resident to get his/her meal(s) to the room.
40. The hostel residents must be dressed properly while going to the mess. They are not allowed in shorts or similar attire in the mess/campus.
41. Food will be served in the mess in buffet style. Wastage in any form must be avoided.
42. The defaulting hostel residents shall be liable to fines/penalties for violation of rules as prescribed by the University.
43. Appeal against the fines/penalties/other actions shall lie with the Vice-Chancellor who will have full powers to reject the appeal or reduce or enhance or modify the action taken by the competent authority.
44. The hostel rules are subject to change from time to time with the approval of the competent authority.

PREVENTION OF RAGGING

1. Ragging is a punishable offence under the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
2. The following will be considered as acts of ragging:
 - i) To physically assault or threat and/or use of physical force.
 - ii) To violate the status, dignity and honour of a student.
 - iii) To expose the student to ridicule and contempt and affect his/her self-esteem.
 - iv) To entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gestures and obscene behavior.
 - v) To compel new comers to indulge in activities amounting to dangerous stunts.
 - vi) To force senior/junior/new students to parade and stage entertainment.
 - vii) To impose heavy financial burden by way of forced celebrations and hosting.
 - viii) To create rowdy celebrations through forcible acts and thus compelling the juniors to participate.
 - (ix) To press the new comers for noisy disorderly scene.
 - (x) To tease, play rough jokes and engage in rough play against companions, especially the new students.
 - (xi) To be noisy and riotous and thus disturbing the peace and tranquility of the Campus.
3. All students are advised to refrain themselves from involving in any sort of ragging activity. Any student found involved in any sort of ragging activities on the campus/bus/hostel, shall invite disciplinary action as per the ruling of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and guidelines issued by UGC/MCI/State High Court/District Court. Such a student may even be expelled from the University.

PREVENTION OF SEXUAL HARASSMENT AND EVE TEASING

The University has 'zero tolerance' policy for any act of sexual harassment. A standing committee for prevention of sexual harassment and eve teasing has been constituted to look into any complaint in this regard.

1. Constitution of Internal Complaints Committee on Sexual Harassment and Eve Teasing

In compliance to the 'The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013', the SGT University has constituted an Internal Complaints Committee on Sexual Harassment and Eve Teasing as per provisions of this Act for the effective enforcement of the basic human right of gender equality and guarantee against sexual harassment and abuse, more particularly against sexual harassment at work place.

2. Objectives of the Committee

The objectives of the Committee are:

- i) to prevent discrimination and sexual harassment against women, by promoting gender equality among students and employees;
- ii) to make recommendations to the University authorities for changes/elaborations in the Rules and Regulations for the students and the staff to make them gender just and to lay down procedures for the prohibition, resolution, settlement and prosecution for acts of discrimination and sexual harassment against women, by the students and the employees;
- iii) to deal with the cases of discrimination and sexual harassment against women, in a time bound manner, aiming at ensuring support services to the victimized and termination of the harassment;
- iv) to recommend appropriate punitive action against the guilty party to the university authorities.

3. Procedure for Approaching the Committee

An aggrieved woman shall make, in writing, a complaint to the Internal Complaints Committee within a period of three months from the date of incident and in case of series of incidents within a period of three months from the date of last incident. The written complaint may be addressed by the victim or a third party to the Convener of the Internal Complaints Committee. If the complaint is made to the Head of the Department/ Dean of the Faculty, or any Committee Member or any other Officer of the University, the same shall be forwarded to the Convener of the Committee. The Committee shall deal with all the complaints of sexual harassment relating to students, staff and faculty studying/working at the SGT University in consonance with the provisions of the Act.

4. The following acts shall be deemed as "unwelcome" sexually determined behaviour (whether directly or by implication):

- i) Physical contact and advances.
- ii) Demand or request for sexual favours.²
- iii) Sexually coloured remarks.
- iv) Showing pornography.
- v) Other unwelcome physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature.
- vi) Eve-teasing.
- vii) Unsavory remarks.
- viii) Jokes causing or likely to cause awkwardness or embarrassment.
- ix) Gender-based innuendos and taunts.
- x) Gender-based insults or sexist remarks.
- xi) Unwelcome sexual overtone in any manner such as over telephone (obnoxious telephone calls) and the like.
- xii) Touching or brushing against any part of the body and the like.
- xiii) Displaying pornographic or other offensive or derogatory pictures, cartoons, pamphlets or sayings.
- xiv) Forcible physical touch or molestation.
- xv) Physical confinement against one's will and any other act likely to violate one's privacy.
