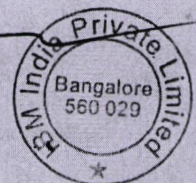

IBM under Career Education Program shall provide the following:



- vi) An MoU may be signed with the Department of A&FW for setting up of aforesaid STL.


