OVERVIEW


The branch of Public Health Dentistry deals with more of general dentistry at the out-reach levels and also with research on oral health care. The role of Public Health Dentist is equally important in today's world as we are able to make the dental care facilities available to the masses & needy people, to whom these services are not available at approachable & affordable standards. We at SGT University believe in planning and executing targeted goals so that we can perform our duties as health care clinicians to alleviate the enormous levels of dental diseases from all the age groups of the society.

The department is regularly conducting outreach activities on daily basis, thus providing screening and treatment for oral diseases in rural as well as urban areas in and around gurgaon-NCR. The objective behind such programs is to make the dental care facilities available to the masses & needy people, to whom these services are not available at approachable & affordable standards. The department has conducted around 153 camps during the year 2017. Around 10000 patients were screened and treated for their ailments at the camp site. Also, the patients were reffered to the Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University for further advanced care. Some of the outreach/ extension activities organised by the department are as follows:

Special Oral Cancer Awareness Drive was conceived by interdisciplinary collaboration of
Department of Oral Pathology & Microbiology and Forensic Odontology and Department of
Public Health Dentistry. It Started on 4th Feb and continued till April 2017.On 15th February
2017, Oral Health treatment camp was organized by Department of Public Health Dentistry,
SGT University as per Private Public Partnership (PPP) agreement with CMO, Gurgaon, at
Government Hospital, Haily Mandi, where in people were screened for Oral Health ailments
and treated accordingly.

Oral Health Education Camp was conducted by SGT University at Sultanpur Village on 21-3 Staff from all the faculties participated in the camp. Dr. Sachin from Dept. of Public Health Dentistry taught the villagers about the importance of oral health.





- 3. A dental screening cum treatment camp was organized in District Jail, Jhajjar on 21st March 2017. A team of 8-9 doctors and two attendants reached the camp site where around 119 prisoners were screened and around 27 treated. Dental ambulance along with the team was taken to accomplish the treatment procedures. This out-reach activity was organized to celebrate WORLD ORAL HEALTH DAY 2017 with theme "LIVE MOUTH SMART"
- 4. A camp was organized on the occasion of **World Health Day 2017** by the Department of Public Health Dentistry, SGT University on 7.4.2017 at Sultanpur, Gurgaon. The camp was

based on the theme given by World Health Organization on the occasion of World Health Day 2017, i.e. "Depression- Let's Talk". A Health talk on Depression and its effect on oral health was given during the camp to the rural people of that area. The camp was concluded by Skit performances from the Department of Physiotherapy and Nursing.

5. A Screening-cum-Treatment Camp at Civil Hospital, Sector 10, Gurgaon on 18th April 2017. A Camp was organised near the OPD area in Civil Hospital.





6. No Tobacco Week

No tobacco week was celebrated from 26th May-31st May 2017 in collaboration with Dept of OMR by carrying out Ralley in village Budhera, guest lecture and health talk for patients and non-teaching staff. People were made aware regarding harmful effects of tobacco and role of tobacco in causing oral cancer. They were also made aware regarding Nicotine Replacement Therapy (chewing gums, tablets) which helps patient in quitting tobacco.



The camp started at 11 am and continued till 2 pm around 116 school children and 10 teaching and non teaching staff were examined. Scaling was done for 20 patients in the mobile dental ambulance of the department. School children were explained about tooth brushing techniques and were given demonstrations for the same. teaching staff were sensitized regarding WORLD AIDS DAY. The purpose of the camp was to impart knowledge regarding oral health, sensitize the population regarding AIDS and provide basic treatment for the needy.









12. The Department of Public Health Dentistry of Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University conducted oral health screening program on 14th December 2017 at Gurukulam Das School, Rewari. An awareness activity was organised in an auditorium within School comprising of dental team for oral health checkup of School children. Around 127 children were examined. Children who required complex dental treatment were referred to SGT University for further procedures. The session was concluded by giving oral health education speech to the School children and their Class teachers. The purpose of the Oral Health talk was to create awareness among the community and make them understand the importance of oral health care.

We at SGT University believe in planning and executing targeted goals so that we can perform our duties as health care clinicians to alleviate the enormous levels of dental diseases from all the age groups of the society.

The department is regularly conducting outreach activities on daily basis, thus providing screening and treatment for oral diseases in rural as well as urban areas in and around gurgaon-NCR. The objective behind such programs is to make the dental care facilities available to the masses & needy people, to whom these services are not available at approachable & affordable standards. The department has conducted around 189 camps during 2018. Around 25000 patients were screened and treated for their ailments at the camp site. Also, the patients were reffered to the Faculty of Dental Sciences, SGT University for further advanced care. We also collaborated with Colgate Palmolive Pvt. India Ltd. for conducting oral health screening exercise at various locations in National Capital Region. We conducted 275 such activities at various locations covering nearly 80,000 school children from 20th November 2018 till December 2018. Some of the outreach/ extension activities organised by the department are as follows:

1. An oral health screening camp was organized by Department of Public Health Dentistry SGT Dental College at Government School, Palra village, Haryana in association with IGD NGO funded by DLF foundation. 49 patients including school children were examined. Patients who required treatment were referred to SGT University for further treatment. Gramin Health card and oral health education material was also distributed among patients. School children were explained about tooth brushing techniques and were given demonstrations for the same. The purpose of the Oral Health screening camp was to create awareness among the community and make them understand the importance of oral health care.



8. World No Tobacco Day is observed around the world every year on 31st May. It is intended to encourage a 24-hour period of abstinence from all forms of tobacco consumption around the globe. Department of public health dentistry, SGT University conducted consecutively 3 Days oral health screening and treatment programme (25th to 27th May 2018) at different location to spread awareness about use of tobacco and its ill effects as well as about its cessation. 1st Day programme was organized at Sondhi village Haryana in association with Reliance where screening of 87 patients including 17 oral prophylaxis and 3 extractions were done. Afterwards, 2nd Day programme was organised at S D Adarsh Vidya Mandir Shivpuri, Gurgaon which was conducted in collaboration with The Rotary Club of Gurgaon, South City. This programme examined 64 children and informed them about serious effects of tobacco on oral and general health. Last Day the programme was conducted at Jatusana village Rewari District Haryana in association with Rotary south Gurugram branch and Gramin Uthan and Bharat Nirman. On this day, a total of 69 patients were screened and told




Here students met with residents; Mr. Dilip who is member of panchayat committee explained how villagers are struggling with poor availability of fresh water. He said that they don't have natural resources of water, only can rely on water supply by government which provides the water daily for one hour. As it is the day which is celebrated for the importance of water Mr. Dilip told how villagers are using the 3'R principal – Reduce, Reuse & Re-cycle. He said to reduce quantity of water they use; they do not use more than one bucket in bath. To 'reuse' the water they use the dirty water to irrigate the plants. To recycle the water, they have made small drains at the side of every street which is connected to a big drain and the treated water goes to a pond where they recycle the water and uses it in agriculture.

It was a ground reporting for students of journalism and as well as students of film making, who are also shot a documentary on this village.
