The Obstetric and gynaecological Nursing department, Faculty of Nursing, SGT University in collaboration with Department of Community Health & Development, ST Stephens Hospital, Delhi-Gurugram has organized a "Mothers to Mothers Health Interaction Training Programme" under TOT(Training of Trainers) on promotion of Home Based Nutrition for infants & toddlers on 9th December 2021 at Budhera Village, Gurugram. The program was started at 11 am. The participants were 25 prominent mothers of the village. A pre-test was administered before to the commencement of the session to determine the level of understanding. Prof. (Dr.) Akoijam Mamata Devi led a session on antenatal care, antenatal visit, and several government initiative programmes connected to maternal care such as Janani Surakshya Yojana, Janani Sishu Surakshya Yojana, MAA, PMSMA, and birth preparedness after the pre-test. Ms Banapriya then discused on antenatal diet and safety precautions to consider throughout pregnancy. The whole programme was organized under the supervision of Prof. (Dr.) Akoijam Mamata Devi, HOD of Obstetrics & Gynaecological Nursing with the faculty members Ms. Banapriya & Mr Abhishek Mishra.
