4. Sanctions and Bill of Quantities (BOQs)

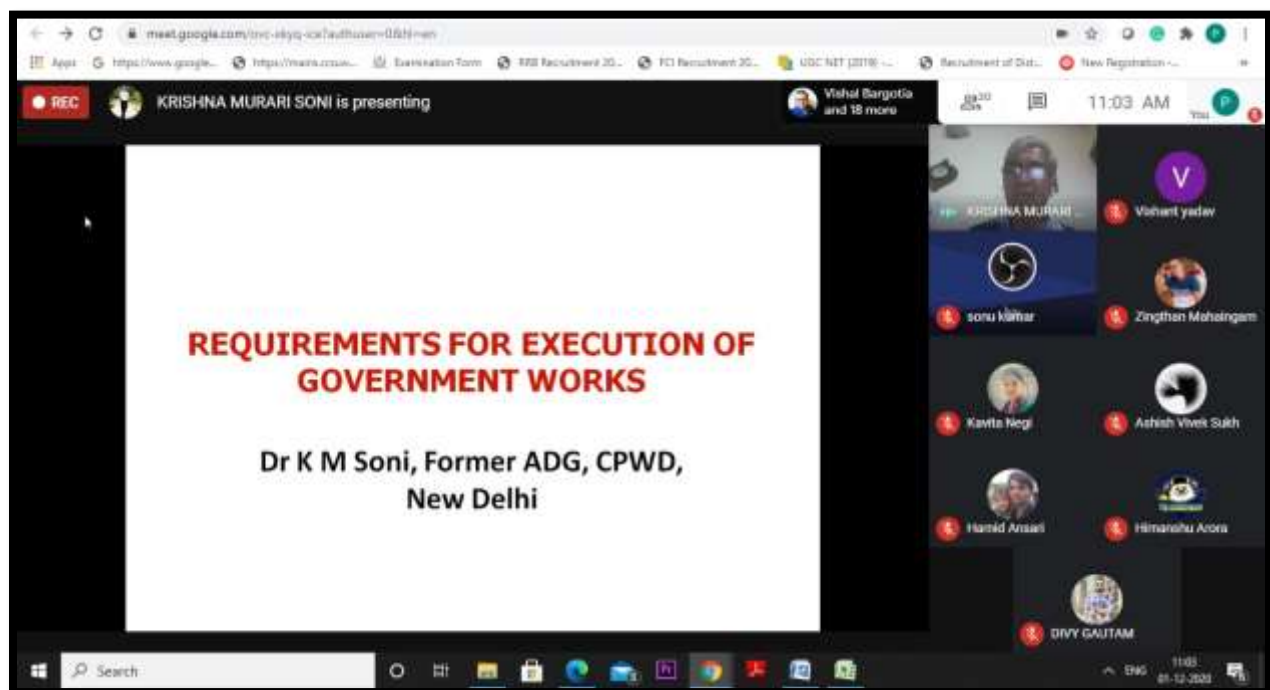
After the speaker ended his presentation, the Q and A Session was conducted for 30 minutes and meanwhile, a Feedback Form is also filled by the participants.

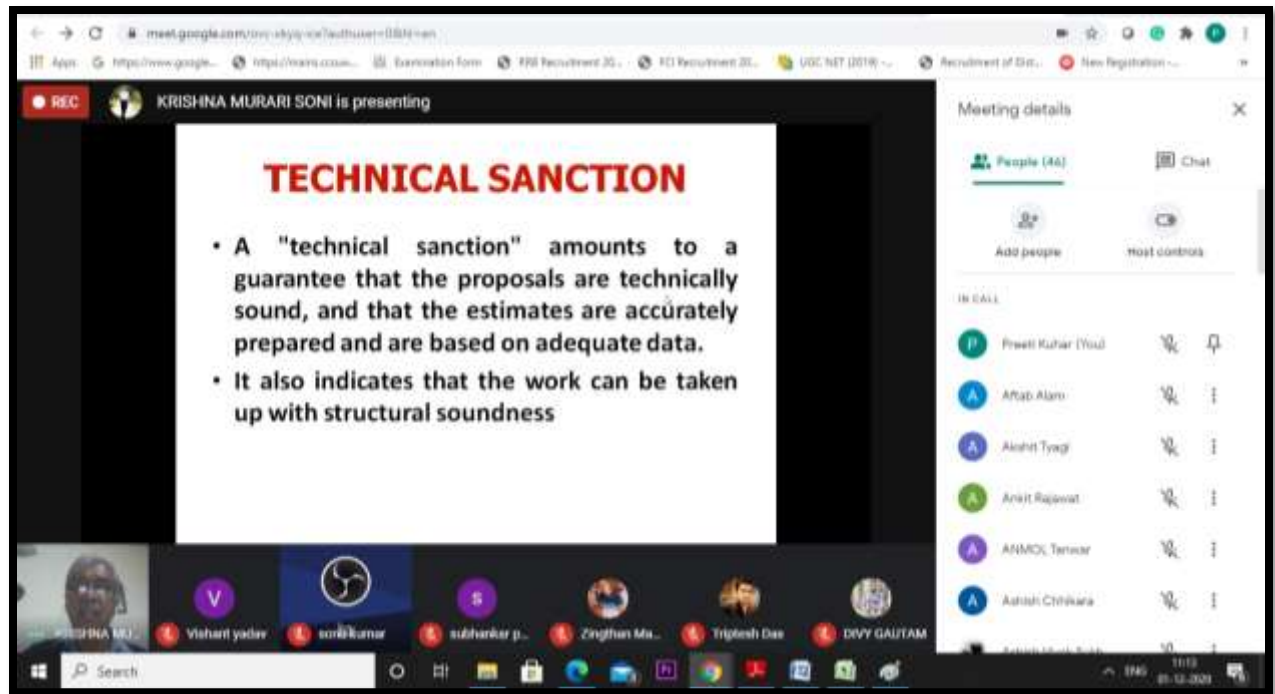
**Learning Outcome:** The webinar was able to make students and faculty members understand the importance of Government Roles in the execution of work.
