

Report of the Webinar/ Event / FDP Program:

a) Introduction:

A seminar was organized on occasion of International Seed Day by Dr. Khushboo Chandra Faculty of Agricultural Sciences, SGT University on topic **'Prospects of Hybrid Seed Production in India'** by Key speaker Prof. (Dr.) I.S.Yadav, Prof. Genetics & Plant Breeding FASC, SGTU (Ex. Prof. & Head CCSHAU, Hisar) on 26th of April 2022 at 11:00 am onwards. The theme for 2022 is "Seed is life of Farmers". There were 91 participants from different sections like Undergraduates, Post graduates, PhD scholars and Faculty members. The brief Introduction about speaker was delivered by Dr. Khushboo Chandra.

Prof. (Dr.) I.S.Yadav during his session pointed out that for farmers reuse of seeds are prohibited so to oppose this concept every year we started celebrating International Seed Day. Earlier people also used to exchange seed materials instead of purchasing it from market. Today's scenario everyone is health conscious so they stated consuming organic produce. He also cited one scene related to Smt. Indira Gandhi and Director general Dr. M.S.Swaminathan in 1960s which leads to green revolution. India is best suited for cultivation of each and every crop due to diversified agro climatic zones and soil properties. In India private seed companies were more flourishing as compared to public seed sector. He also quoted that in India production of seed is cheapest due to maximum availability of labors at low wages. If quality of seed is increased, then ultimately this will enhance production and productivity even under environmental stressed condition. He explained various technical terms relation to Seed Production Technology, different classes of seeds and production of Hybrids.

Sir cited one example that in wheat, variety "C306" is best suited for chapatti making and if this variety is exposed to maximum irrigation and fertilizer application results in lodging of crop. In India, 15 State Seed Corporation, 2 National Seed Corporation is located. Sir also explained about different categories of seed producing companies like Monsanto, Mahyco. During his talk, he emphasized more about lagging behind production of vegetables seed; mostly Cole crop seeds like cabbage and cauliflower were imported. Then he concluded session by discussing constraints in varietal and hybrid seed production, lack of promotion of public seed companies as well as production technology.

Several queries of participants were satisfied by speaker and Vote of thanks was given by Dr. Khushboo Chandra.
