

During the meeting detailed discussion was held on all the agenda points. The suggestions of the members were noted for appropriately incorporating in the ordinance. The detail is as under:

Agenda-I

1. The syllabus of existing courses i.e., B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, M.Sc. Horticulture and M.Sc. Agronomy will remain unchanged.
2. One non-credit Master's Seminar will be added to all the Master Degree programs offered in the faculty to enhance presentation and communication skills.
3. The committee also reviewed the intake capacity of the existing PG programs in the subjects of Agronomy and Horticulture and approved the revised intake capacity of seats from 10 to 5 in each subject.
4. The title of courses of M.Sc. Horticulture and M.Sc. Agronomy program will be renamed as follows:

Agenda-II

1. The committee approved the introduction of new programs of B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture from the academic session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of 30 seats.
2. The committee also approved the introduction of PG program in the subjects of Plant Pathology, Entomology, Genetics & Plant Breeding and Soil Science & Agricultural Chemistry from the academic session 2020-21 with intake capacity of 5 seats in each subject.
3. All the elementary/ fundamental/ principle courses in B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture will be rearranged and ordinance will be modified accordingly. All such courses will be offered in 1st year/ early semesters based on their credit load.
4. The syllabus of all the PG programs should be checked and if needed be modified in line with syllabus of ASRB and standard academic institutions/universities.
5. The courses offered as 'Major Courses' should be arranged from introductory to advance level.
6. Titles of all the courses in all PG programs should be checked and verified with the ordinance of standard academic institutions/universities.
7. Some courses from Biotechnology, Microbiology, Biochemistry and Crop Physiology should be offered as "Minor Courses" for various PG programs.
8. To strengthen academic programs and quality education, faculty outsourcing via various online/offline platforms should be a regular feature.


Agenda-III
