The Vice Chancellor welcomed the members of the Admission Committee. He asked all the members to give their suggestions on the course to be offered in the next Academic Session and also their eligibility criteria for admissions. Also requested to all the Deans to find out the courses needs to be dropped out for which there is no scope and no admissions were in the last Academic Session. He emphasized that the eligibility criteria should be strictly as per the regulatory bodies and within course it should be relevant for pursuing the courses. He further stated that we should aim at increasing the strength of the students.

The Registrar placed the agenda before the Committee and explained that the Admissions Committee decides the policy guidelines relating to admissions to various courses as per the requirement of the Harvana Private Universities Act 2006 (as amended from time to time) and the Regulating Bodies as well as to finalize the list of the courses to be offered from the Academic Session 2017-18 along with the eligibility criteria, intake and other issues.
