### REVISED SCHEME OF EXAMINATIONS FOR MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING PROGRAMME W.E.F. ACADEMIC SESSION 2019-20

- Note 1: All Question Papers except "Nursing Research & Statistics" will have three parts. Part 1 will have three (03) Long Essay Type questions each of 15 marks out of which the student will attempt two (02) questions; Part 2 will have two (02) Short Essay Type questions each of 10 marks; and Part 3 will have seven (07) Short Answer Type questions each of five (05) marks out of which the student will attempt five (05) questions.
- Note 2: Paper "Nursing Research & Statistics" will have two Sections—Section 1 and Section 2.

  Section 1 "Nursing Research" will be of 50 marks and Section 2 "Statistics" will be of 25 marks.

Section 1 of Part 1 will have two (02) Long Essay Type questions each of 15 marks out of which the student will attempt one (01) questions; Part 2 will have two (02) Short Essay Type questions each of 10 marks; Part 3 will have five (05) Short Answer Type questions each of five (05) marks out of which the student will attempt three (03) questions.

Section 2 of Part 1 will have two (02) Short Essay Type question of 10 marks out of which the student will attempt one (01) questions; Part 2 of this Section will have two (05) Short Answer Type questions each of 05 marks out of which the student will attempt three (03) questions.
