MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE BLIND RELIEF  
ASSOCIATION, DELHI AND SRI GOVIND TRICENTENARY DENTAL COLLEGE,  
HOSPITAL & RESEARCH INSTITUTE, GURGAON, REGARDING SETTING UP  
DENTAL CLINIC

The Blind Relief Association, Delhi is a leading NGO in Delhi providing educational, vocational training and rehabilitation services to visually challenged persons. The Association runs a residential senior secondary school for boys, a college for special education specializing on visual impairment, a wide range of vocational training for adult blind men and women. Nearly 300 visually challenged children and adult residing in the Association's hostels receive the benefit of education and imparted to them. Besides the students and trainees there are nearly 100 staff members working in the Association's various units.

Sri Govind Tricentenary Dental College, Hospital & Research Institute being run by Dashmesh Educational Charitable Trust is a major dental college based in Gurgaon. The College has a community outreach programme under which dental treatment and care services are provided free to several villages in and around Gurgaon.

Based on the assessment made during a dental camp organized by the College in the Association's premises in November 2008, it was realized that a regular programme to monitor the dental health and provide dental care services to the school students, vocational trainees and staff of the Association needs to be set up in the Association's premises.

Sri Govind Tricentenary Dental College, Hospital & Research Institute offers to set up in the Association's premises a well-equipped dental clinic to provide free services to the Association's students, trainees and staff.

As an extension service of the College, the clinic will be set up, equipped, maintained and run by the College, with all the expenditure incurred for the same to be borne by the College.

The Dental Clinic will run regularly on one designated day every week

To begin with the clinic will primarily serve the students, trainees and staff of the Association without charge. However, later on, with the consent of the Association's management the clinic may expand its services to cover visually challenged persons from outside as well.

All services provided by the clinic will be free of charge

In setting up and running the Dental Clinic the Blind Relief Association will be responsible to provide the following facilities:

- i) A suitable place, within the Association's Medical Room to set up the dental clinic facilities;
- ii) Water and electric power
- iii) Air conditioning
- iv) General assistance of the Association's Medical Room staff on the clinic day

The College will be responsible to provide the following:

- 1) All professional equipment, such as dental chair unit, wall-mounted X-ray unit, autoclave etc.
- 2) Dentistry Instruments and implements
- 3) Expendables on day to day basis
- 4) Laboratory facilities for fabrication of dental prosthesis
- 5) Plumbing, carpentry, painting work for setting up the dental clinic section
- 6) Dentist and technical support staff to run the clinic services, including maintenance of record of the patients
- 7) ~~Plumbing, carpentry, painting work for setting up the dental clinic section~~

All the equipment installed, instruments and implements and other property brought by the College shall be the property of the College.

The College will have a name board suitably posted outside the Clinic. The wordings of the board shall be decided mutually by the two sides.

The College will be free to make a mention of the Dental Clinic in its reports, journals and other publications.

Should either the Association or the College wish to discontinue the arrangement, it can do so by giving one month notice.

This Memorandum of Understanding has been signed in New Delhi between the Blind Relief Association, Delhi and Sri Govind Tricentenary Dental College, Hospital & Research Institute on 14th of February 2009.
